### We urge you to also take account of two very important pieces of additional advice about voting preferences.

**NB 1:** If candidates are standing in a *regional* constituency, in their own branch they should put themselves as '1' on the voting advice, and then follow the rest of the ordering.

So in the North East Region HE election, Gavin Reid who appears as preference 2 on the main national list would be preference 1 at Leeds University which is his branch.

**NB 2:** If candidates are standing in a *national* constituency, such the Equality seats or the UK-Elected seats, in their own Region they should put themselves as '1' on the voting advice, and then follow the rest of the ordering.

For example, in the UK-Elected FE list where Umit Yildiz appears as number 3 on the national voting advice, he should alter that so that in the North East constituency he appears as preference 1, and the other preferences are re-ordered accordingly.

Or in the HE-Elected preference list for Lesley McGorrigan, she should alter the list so that she appears as number 1 in the North East voting region, and the others are re-ordered.
